I have looked into various flights leaving London on the 21st June 2010 to arrive into Bangalore, India on the 22nd June 2010.

The following flight is the 'recommended' flight based on time and price for those of you who may like to catch the same flight. The cheapest seats I found on this flight were offered by Expedia and are with British Airways.

You are welcome to look around and buy any flight you wish, providing you are at the airport in Bangalore to meet this flight at 04:15 am local time on 22nd June 2010.

Outward – 21st June 2010

Flight No: BA119

Depart: London Heathrow (T5) @ 1350

Arrive: Bangalore @ 04:15 on 22nd June

Inbound – 16 September 2010 *

Flight No: BA118

Depart: Bangalore @ 06:50

Arrive: London Heathrow (T5) @ 12:35

If you are going on a different outbound flight to the above then you **MUST** be at Bangalore airport to meet this flight at 04:50am on 22nd June 2010.

It is **imperative** that we pick everyone up together at this time.

If you aren't returning on the recommended inbound flight, then please ensure you get a flight that leaves no earlier than the recommended flight.

Passports and Visas

You will need a full 5 or 10 year British passport for the expedition. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after expedition.

Holders of British passports **DO** require visas for India – **please see visa post on forum.**

Volunteer's who do not hold British passports should contact their embassy for information about their visa requirements.



***An unofficial yet important message from the Programme Manager Mark**

We always finish our expedition with a well deserved staff party after the venturers leave. We have quite a lot of reports and paperwork to do at this time as well as putting field base to bed in preparation for the next expedition. Because there is so much going on during this staff 'wash-up' period we have the party on the night before the official return flight as detailed above. In order to make the most of the party you will not want to travel the next day to Bangalore airport. For this reason we recommend you arrange to get the same flight the next day or later if you plan to travel on in India, which many do.

You should note your JLT insurance cover ends on the date of the official return flight at of end of expedition. So you should extend cover accordingly. We will of course make sure you get to your Bangalore flights; either the one above or the same one 24hrs later. All other onward travel is at your own arrangement otherwise.
