

## **A Legacy to Raleigh International Trust**

The generosity of spirit of those who give us their final gift is truly humbling. It may not be pleasant to think about the end of our own life, but many of us have taken the step of writing a Will. If you haven't, but wish to, you should speak to your solicitor.

Of course, your promise of a legacy to Raleigh International Trust is a very clear way of saying how much you value and appreciate the work we do with young people.

But it is also a way for almost anyone to make a very significant donation. Whilst you may not think of yourself as "cash-rich", remembering Raleigh International Trust in your Will is an opportunity to make the sort of large donation you could never afford during your life.

## **Adding Raleigh International Trust to your Will**

You can add Raleigh International Trust to your Will using a document called a **Codicil**, such as the one enclosed. The process is very simple:

- Fill in your **name and address** and the **date of your last Will**.
- Pick **one of the bequest options** (delete the other three):
  - “all the residue...” to leave us **everything** in your estate;
  - “the sum of...” to leave a **specific amount** (write the amount in words);
  - “one...” to leave a **part of your estate** (write what fraction; e.g. half, tenth);
  - “the following item(s)...” to leave a **specific item** (write exactly what it is).
- Ask **two Witness** to watch you sign the Codicil, then complete the bottom section.
- Then send the **original Codicil to your solicitor**, keeping a copy for your records.
