

# Adventure challenge events manager

## The role

On our 5 week expeditions venturers complete a team based adventure challenge. The adventure challenge events manager is responsible to the Raleigh in-country staff for organising and delivering this physically and mentally challenging event. You'll have four weeks to plan the event, this includes agreeing the site and activities, risk assessments, casualty evacuation planning, and the necessary logistics support. You will also receive support from other volunteer managers on your expedition.

## Structure

Phase 1 is three to four days long and includes activities designed to develop confidence, outdoor skills and problem solving abilities. The teams will 'wild camp' during this phase and be awarded points for team work, initiative, problem-solving and successfully completing set tasks.

Phase 2 may include a head to head race where all teams simultaneously navigate around a pre-determined course encountering various additional challenges along the way such as a casualty evacuation and river crossings. Points gained during phase 1 will provide team with time advantages.

## The responsibilities

Overall you'll be working within the guidelines set by Raleigh in-country staff to plan and deliver a safe, exciting, fun and developmentally sound challenge event that enables young people to develop 'outdoor skills' and build on teamwork, leadership, confidence, fitness and problem solving abilities.

## The skills

- Qualified summer mountain leader
- Experience of working with young people
- Confident and able to manage a team and work within guidelines with minimal supervision
- Willingness to be flexible and put the needs of the expedition and the venturers first

## Desirable skills

- Canoeing/SPA qualification
